



### **Child Psychologist Opening**

The Dirksen Center for Neurobehavioral Health (DCN) seeks a licensed clinical psychologist (or immediately license-eligible in IL) to provide therapy, and for those interested assessment, for children and adolescents in private practice and primary care consultative settings. Therapists currently work alongside pediatricians and DCN neuropsychologists to provide outpatient intervention for children, adolescents, and families in our main office and in the offices of our partner pediatricians in Crystal Lake, IL. The most frequent referrals pertain to anxiety, ADHD, depression, parent training, behavioral difficulties, sleep issues, and feeding/eating concerns. Experience in primary care or other medical settings and those with expertise in childhood trauma are preferred. Opportunity to conduct developmental or psychological assessment is available. This is a 1099 position with flexibility regarding part-time or full-time caseload and the option for W2 employment in the future. Scheduling is flexible but given that most patients are of school-age, applicants should have at least some availability outside of typical school hours.

The Dirksen Center is an established and growing pediatrics-focused private practice located in Arlington Heights, IL, consisting of 6 doctoral-level psychologists (3 neuropsychologists), trainees, administrative staff, and practice managers. Administrative support including scheduling, billing, verification of benefits, and paneling/credentialing support is in place.
